## COMMON GROUNDS NEWS AND NEEDS

The Common Grounds Annual Report has been completed for <u>2019</u>. We thought it might be helpful for you to know some statistics that will help you see the impact our mission outreach is making on our local community. They are the following:

Families Common Grounds helped: 910 Number of New Families: 135 Actual Number of People helped: 2290 Average Monthly Income: \$720.79

In addition, the number of volunteers from our church who served in different capacities is <u>16</u>. This number does not include our faithful Knit Wits, our scouts, and our youth group. The Knit Wits have made us dish cloths and baby blankets to distribute, our scouts brought many bags of donated food and sorted it, and our youth came and filled our Thanksgiving boxes for distribution. We could not fulfill our mission at Common Grounds without the help of so many. What a blessing all of them are! Perhaps you think you might be interested in volunteering at Common Grounds. We really could use your help. Please contact Susan Vieweg or Pam Higgs and come to the mission outreach to see what we do, how we work, and whether you'd like to be a part of our neighborhood outreach. We'd welcome you! (Note: We are only open from 10:00 AM– 2:00 PM on Tuesdays and Thursdays if that is a consideration.)

The end of January Common Grounds has applied for the West Virginia United Methodist Conference's Hunger Grant. We applied for it last year (and prior years). In 2019 we were awarded up to \$1000 depending upon money that came in. By the end of the year we had received \$817.34. How grateful we are our conference supports mission outreaches of their local churches! That gift has been quite valuable to our operations this year.

You may place them in the woven trunk in the open area in the Narthex.
