COMMON GROUNDS NEWS AND NEEDS

Fall is upon us and at Common Grounds we're looking forward to the upcoming holidays. During the entire month of October, in addition to our usual volunteer work, we sign up families for our Thanksgiving boxes. We limit sign-ups to this month so we can determine how many boxes we will need to provide. During early November, we collect the needed boxes; we also gather and order the needed food for each box. The families which sign up for a Thanksgiving box will receive a complete Thanksgiving meal, including a turkey, gravy, stuffing mix, green beans, cranberry sauce, sweet potatoes, baking potatoes, dinner rolls, butter, and a pumpkin pie. We have you to thank for all your donations to these boxes. The Thanksgiving Food Collection we have in our church four Sundays prior to Thanksgiving comes at such a great time and those foods are used to fill the boxes and ultimately help an underprivileged family in our area have a great Thanksgiving! Isn't it wonderful to be a part of that?!!

In addition we are signing up qualified families for the United Way Christmas Bureau program. These families will receive a Christmas dinner as well as toys and clothes for children ages 12 years and under. It's a joy and privilege to work with the other local agencies to provide for those in need....especially at Christmas!

As we enter the last quarter of the year, it seems like a good time to share a few statistics from Common Grounds operations for the first six months of this year. During this time we served <u>976</u> families and <u>56</u> of those families are new families. The average monthly income is \$728.83.
