Some suggestions are the following: peanut butter and jelly, fruit in its own juice, unsweetened family-sized cereal, green beans, corn, mixed vegetables, canned tuna or chicken, pasta and spaghetti sauce, mac 'n' cheese, baked beans, soup of any kind, pancake mix, and syrup. We are also looking forward to signing up families for the United Way Christmas Bureau offerings.
